## COUNCIL MEETINGS 2019-2020

In 2019-2020, there were five Council meetings scheduled. Most Council meetings include the following standard reports:

- student report, by student representative Mansi Sethi, sharing non-academic events organized by and for students (grades 9-12 only) throughout the year;
- teacher reports, by teacher representatives Chris Wilson representing Grades 7 & 8 and Julia Saunders representing Grades 9-12, sharing notable academic activities or events; and
- principal's report, by Wendy Verreault, providing a global perspective on SRB, leadership initiatives within SRB, the impact of various board-wise initiatives on SRB such as the amalgamation, as well as financial reporting

Other members also report to Council when required. The SRB School Council representatives to OCASC (Ottawa Carleton Assembly of School Councils), Helen Norman, shared news and ideas from the regular meetings of this body to help inform our School Council's discussions.

In additional to the standard reports, key discussions, presentations, and events that took place at each meeting are summarized below:

- **September 10, 2019:** Update on summer construction. Tour of the new gym. Request for staff reports to be provided electronically so they can be posted with other meeting minutes. Elections for Council seats also took place. Carmen Parsons will represent Grades 9-12 as chair.
- November 12, 2019: Meeting cancelled due to inclement weather.
- January 14, 2020: The meeting was moved to Mr. Shea's room to hear him speak about the SHSM in Architecture that is offered at SRB. One tip of note was to consider the courses required to obtain the SHSM while the student is in grade 9 or 10 and make a plan to fit all requirements in since this can be challenging.
- March 10, 2020: Cancelled due to school power outage.
- May 12, 2020: Cancelled due to pandemic
- **June 9, 2020:** Cancelled due to pandemic. 2020-2021 planning and dates for 2020-2021 meetings done via email with principal Wendy Verrault.
