



# OCDSB ICELAND 2018

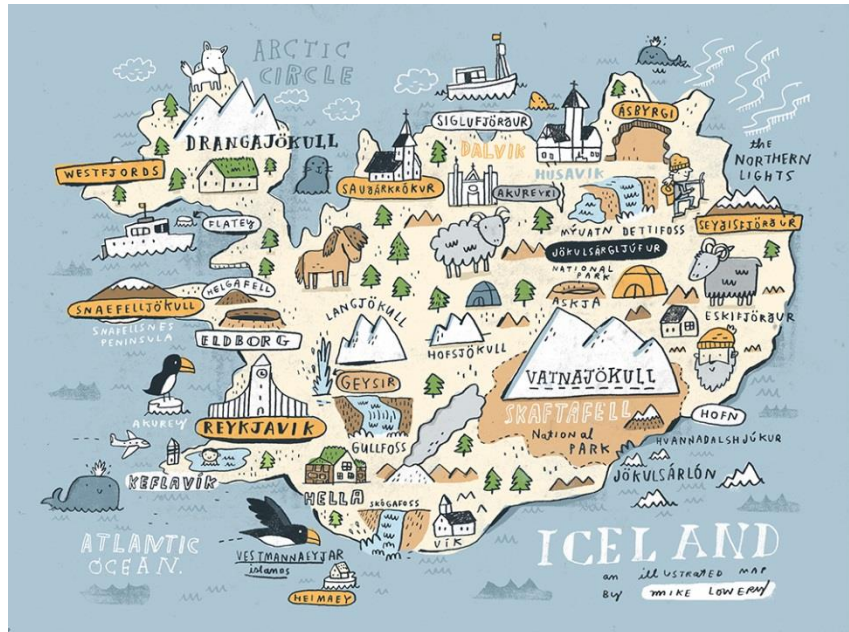
## GLACIERS, GEYSERS, VOLCANOES & TECTONIC PLATES

**WHEN?** June 23-28 2018 (the week after final exams)

**WHO?** This is a trip for all OCDSB students in grades 9-12 who are interested in a geography / Earth science focused trip. Mr. R. Barter (A.Y. Jackson S.S.) and Mrs. Hughes (Longfields-Davidson Heights S.S.) will be the trip supervisors.

**WHAT?** Highlights include:

- Soak in the Blue Lagoon hot spring in Reykjavik
- Thingvellir National Park (see where the continental plates meet)
- Visit the Gullfoss & Skogarfoss Waterfalls
- Geysir geothermal lands (learn how to cook using the Earth's heat)
- See the midnight sun and the maybe the northern lights
- Walk on a glacier in the Thorsmork Glacier Valley
- Investigate Iceland's active volcanoes
- Explore the village of Vik (learn about the Vikings)
- Hike in the Reykjadalur Valley
- Walk under the Earth in the Raufarhólshellir Lava Tunnels



**HOW MUCH?** The trip will cost \$3165 which covers everything (3 meals a day, gratuities, full travel insurance) except your spending money (souvenirs and snacks).
