Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) programs feature a combination of in-class and practical experiences, with the benefit of specialized facilities, equipment and teacher expertise. Students enrolled in SHSM programs may attend a host school for one semester and then return to their home school to complete diploma requirements. **Please note the following:**

- Students requesting a Specialist High Skills Major program must review detailed program descriptions found in *Secondary School Courses* available on the web at www.ocdsb.ca.
- Admission to these programs is subject to space availability and the approval of both the home and host school principals.
- A host school may request an interview with the student prior to acceptance into the program.
- Students will be notified of the status of their request through their Student Services/Guidance department by the end of April 2018.
- Transportation is provided.
- Students enrolled in the Construction Projects program must be 16 years of age or older.
- Since the time of publication, other SHSM programs may have been approved, in addition to the ones listed below. Check with your Guidance counsellor for an up-to-date list of available programs.
